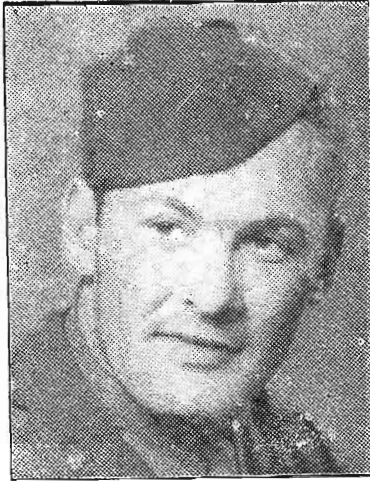




LAWLESS THIBODEAUX
